



### Notification of Enhanced Pistol Training Course

On 28-29 October 2019, **Hampton Police Division** will host Combined Firearms Training's **Enhanced Pistol Training Course** at **Hampton VA**. This course is a two day 16 hour Law Enforcement training program approved and certified by the National Rifle Association's Law Enforcement Activities Division and has been submitted for 16 hours of Virginia DCJS partial in service credit. Your agency is eligible to receive a reduced rate of \$400.00 per seat to our 28-29 October class. These slots are **Limited** and are first come first serve basis. Attached to your email you have been provided a description and equipment requirements for the tactical carbine course. We hope you will share this information with your officers.
