



Notification of Pistol Training Course

On 25 May 2019, Combined Firearms Training's **Pistol Training Course will be hosted Waynesboro Police Department at Waynesboro VA**. This course is a One day 8 hour Law Enforcement training program and is approved by the National Rifle Association's Law Enforcement Activities Division and has been submitted to Virginia **DCJS** for 8 hours of **DCJS Credit**. Your agency is eligible to receive a reduced rate of \$225.00 per seat in our 25 May class.

Combined Firearms Training is a Disabled American Veteran owned company.
