



Notification of Pistol Training Course

On April 20th 2019, Combined Firearms Training's **Pistol Training Course will be hosted By Richmond Police Department**. This course is a one day 8 hour Law Enforcement training program approved by the National Rifle Association's Law Enforcement Activities Division and has been submitted **for 8 hours of VA,DCJS in service credit**. Your agency is eligible to receive a reduced rate of \$225.00 per seat in our April 20th class. Attached to your email you have been provided a description and equipment requirements for the tactical carbine course. We hope that you will share this information with your officers.
